TITLE I, PART A IMPROVING BASIC PROGRAMS

- PURPOSE: SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPORT TO SCHOOLS WITH HIGH PERCENTAGES OF STUDENTS FROM LOW-INCOME FAMILIES TO HELP ENSURE THAT ALL CHILDREN MEET THE STATE'S CHALLENGING ACADEMIC STANDARDS
- ENTITLEMENT: \$1,255,960

TITLE I PART C MIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAM

- THE PURPOSE OF THE MIGRANT EDUCATION PROGRAM IS TO DESIGN AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS THAT HELP MIGRATORY STUDENTS OVERCOME THE CHALLENGES OF MOBILITY, CULTURAL AND LANGUAGE BARRIERS, SOCIAL ISOLATION, AND OTHER DIFFICULTIES ASSOCIATED WITH A MIGRATORY LIFESTYLE. THESE EFFORTS ARE AIMED AT HELPING MIGRATORY STUDENTS SUCCEED IN SCHOOL AND SUCCESSFULLY TRANSITION TO POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION AND/OR EMPLOYMENT.

TITLE II PART A SUPPORTING EFFECTIVE INSTRUCTION

- THE PURPOSE OF TITLE II, PART A IS TO INCREASE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT CONSISTENT WITH THE CHALLENGING STATE ACADEMIC STANDARDS; IMPROVE THE QUALITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF TEACHERS, PRINCIPALS, AND OTHER SCHOOL LEADERS; INCREASE THE NUMBER OF EFFECTIVE TEACHERS, PRINCIPALS, AND OTHER SCHOOL LEADERS WHO ARE EFFECTIVE IN IMPROVING STUDENT ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT IN SCHOOLS; AND PROVIDE LOW-INCOME AND MINORITY STUDENTS GREATER ACCESS TO EFFECTIVE TEACHERS, PRINCIPALS, AND OTHER SCHOOL LEADERS.

TITLE III PART A ENGLISH LANGUAGE ACQUISITION

- PURPOSE: ENSURE THAT ENGLISH LEARNERS (ELS) ATTAIN ENGLISH PROFICIENCY AND DEVELOP HIGH LEVELS OF ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT IN ENGLISH AND MEET THE SAME STATE ACADEMIC STANDARDS THAT ALL CHILDREN ARE EXPECTED TO MEET.

- PURPOSE: PROVIDE ALL STUDENTS ACCESS TO A WELL-ROUNDED EDUCATION, IMPROVE ACADEMIC OUTCOMES BY MAINTAINING SAFE AND HEALTHY STUDENTS AND IMPROVE THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY TO ADVANCE STUDENT ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT
- ENTITLEMENTS: \$140,928

IDEA, PART B ASSISTANCE FOR ALL CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

- **PURPOSE:** MAKE AVAILABLE A FREE APPROPRIATE PUBLIC EDUCATION TO ELIGIBLE CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES AND ENSURES SPECIAL EDUCATION AND RELATED SERVICES TO THOSE CHILDREN.

PERKINS V: STRENGTHENING CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

- PURPOSE: DEVELOP MORE FULLY THE ACADEMIC, TECHNICAL, AND EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS OF SECONDARY EDUCATION STUDENTS WHO ELECT TO ENROLL IN CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

EDUCATION OF HOMELESS CHILDREN & YOUTH

- PURPOSE: IDENTIFY AND REMOVE BARRIERS FOR HOMELESS CHILDREN AND UNACCOMPANIED YOUTH AND ENSURE THAT STUDENTS HAVE EQUITABLE ACCESS TO ALL AVAILABLE SUPPORTS AND RESOURCES TO MEET THE SAME CHALLENGING STATE ACADEMIC STANDARDS ESTABLISHED FOR ALL STUDENTS
